2024 WORK

 Hosted Northern Michigan Policy Conference with record-breaking attendance, featuring Governor Gretchen Whitmer, Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson, House Speaker Joe Tate, LEO Director Susan Corbin, MSHDA Director Amy Hovey, ORP Director Sarah Lucas, and several regional State legislators

Launched advocacy efforts to safeguard Michigan's small rural businesses, seasonal employers, and tipped workers from the supreme court ruling enacting the Michigan Earned Sick Time Act and new Minimum Wage laws

Hosted Michigan Economic Development Corporations Government Affairs and Regional Prosperity team for roundtable discussion on the statewide economic development strategy, Make It In Michigan

Advocated for budget priorities including affordable housing projects, the Office of Rural Prosperity, RAP Program, Pure Michigan, Going PRO Talent Fund, Michigan Achievement Scholarship and Michigan Reconnect

Coordinated the regional Voter Election Guide with questionnaires from candidates running for House of Representatives and U.S. House and Senate seats across the Alliance footprint

Attended important legislative events across the State such as the Mackinaw Policy Conference, UP 200, Northwest Michigan Housing Summit, Michigan Chamber Day at the Capitol, and State of the State
